

## Arcadia Talks with Michelle Reale at the Elkins Park Library and on Zoom

Dr. Michelle Reale is a professor at Arcadia University and the author of several poetry collections. Dr. Reale conducted seven years of ethnography in Sicily among African and Syrian refugees. The poems in the resulting collection, Confini: Poems of Refugees in Sicily, evocatively represent the lived experiences of people fleeing turmoil and settling in a place far from home. 
