With your CTLS card you have the power to:

- Borrow books, magazines, DVDs, museum passes, ukuleles, and much more from any of the CTLS branches & most Montgomery County (MCLINC) Libraries.
- Request over 2.5 million items owned by the one of the 16 MCLINC libraries. Place a request through the catalog and the first available copy will be sent to the library of your choice.
- Access our digital resources 24/7, including ebooks, audiobooks, comics, movies and series, music, magazines, newspapers, crafting tutorials, practice tests, language learning, Consumer Reports, Value Line, and research databases.
- Use your card's blue Access PA sticker in most public libraries across Pennsylvania.
- Use interlibrary loan service to access over 40 million books and other items through the state-wide catalog.
- Answering questions is our super power! Have your questions answered in the branch, over the phone, through email, on social media or through our website's Ask-a-Librarian form.

Checking out: Your library card or ID with address is required to check out materials from our libraries. See the insert for details.

Returns: Return most items at any MCLINC library. Museum passes, board games, and hot spots need to be returned to their owning library.

Renewals: Most CTLS materials can be renewed, unless a request has been placed on them by another patron. Eligible Items will be renewed automatically 3 days before the due date. Inter-library loans are non-renewable.

Requests: Requests may be placed at the library, online, or by phone with your library card. Ask about inter-library loan for materials that are not in our collections.
